Privacy Policy

Scope of this notice

This document applies to all personal data collected while submitting, updating or withdrawing a proposal in the context of one of the [FFplus](#) Open Calls through the FFplus submission site at <https://calls.cesga.es>.

For the purpose of this document, the term “GDPR” refers to the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.

The following terms shall have, in the context of this document, the meaning defined in the GDPR: “controller”, “processor”, “third party”, “personal data”, “data subject”.

In the context of FFplus Open Calls, your data is processed by the following organization as data controller:

Sharing of personal data with third parties

If the proposal is selected, the contact data indicated in the proposal (full name, email address, professional competences, telephone number) will be shared with the FFPlus Project Partners (<https://www.ffplus-project.eu/en/about/project-partners/>) to enable collaboration, communication and networking in line with the objectives of the participation in the sub-projects. Scapos acts as data controller for the initial collection and disclosure of this information to the Project Partners. Once the data has been shared, each recipient Project Partner acts as an independent data controller under the GDPR and is responsible for ensuring lawful, fair, and transparent processing of the data.

Data Transfers

The personal data you provide may be transferred outside the European Economic Area solely for the purpose of evaluating your proposal. All transfers to third-countries are covered by an adequacy decision or by Standard Contractual Clauses that provide a level of protection equivalent to that required in the EU. Once the evaluation is completed, the data used for the evaluation will be deleted and any data that must be retained for legal, archival or statistical purposes will be stored exclusively on servers located within the EU/EEA.

The legal basis for this processing and transfer is Article 6(1)(b) of GDPR.

Data Subject's Rights

Under GDPR, you have the following rights:

- **Right of Access (pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR):** Information about your stored data
- **Right of Rectification (pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR):** Correction of incorrect data
- **Right of Erasure (pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR):** Deletion when data no longer necessary
- **Right of Restriction (pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR):** Limitation of processing
- **Right to Object (pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR):** Opposition to processing based on legitimate interest
- **Right to Data Portability (pursuant to Art. 20 GDPR):** Receive data in structured format, based on consent (Art. 6(1)(a)) or contract (Art. 6(1)(b))
- **Right to Withdraw Consent (pursuant to Art. 7(3) GDPR):** For consent-based processing according to art. 6 lett. A) of GDPR
